

## SURROGATE COMPENSATION OREGON, COLORADO AND WASHINGTON

*The amounts below are estimates. Your compensation may vary based on your circumstances.*

STANDARD COMPENSATION	
First time surrogate's base fee (experienced surrogates receive \$42,000)	\$37,000
Monthly expense allowance (\$200 per month for average of 13 months)	\$2,600
Payment for embryo transfer (\$500 at start of IVF cycle, \$300 at transfer)	\$800
Maternity clothing allowance (surrogates carrying multiples receive \$750)	\$500
<b>Total standard compensation</b>	<b>\$40,900</b>

VARIABLE COMPENSATION	
Compensation for multiples (amount per additional child)	\$5,000
Invasive procedures (amount per procedure)	\$750
Cesarean section	\$1,500
Termination of pregnancy (after end of 13 <sup>th</sup> week)	\$2,000
Loss of uterus	\$5,000
Loss of ovary or ovaries and/or fallopian tube(s)	\$2,500
Counseling (amount available if needed)	\$1,000

REIMBURSEMENT FOR BED REST	
Lost wages (based on income)	Varies
Childcare (based on amount required beyond usual)	Varies
Housekeeping	Varies

INSURANCE	
If the surrogate does not have medical or life insurance, the intended parents provide them.	

MEDICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL SCREENING AND MEDICAL PROCEDURES	
All of the surrogate's medical and psychological screenings and medical procedures are paid for by the intended parents.	

ATTORNEY FEES	
The surrogate's attorney fees for review of the surrogacy contract and finalization of parental rights are paid for by the intended parents.
